

Scheduling Surgery

Who To Contact

- When you have decided to have surgery, please call my surgery scheduler at (559) 256-5245
- The surgery scheduler will help you pick a date for surgery, schedule preoperative lab work, and schedule a pre-operative appointment if needed.
- The surgery scheduler will also work on insurance approval for the procedure and give you an estimated cost of the procedure based on facility.

Medical Clearances

- Some patients will require medical clearance from their primary care physician, cardiologist, pulmonologist, or another physician before scheduling surgery.
- The clearance(s) will need to be competed prior to scheduling surgery

Medications

- A nurse from the surgical facility will contact you about what medications you can and cannot take before surgery
- Blood thinners (Aspirin, Coumadin, Eliquis, etc) usually needs to be stopped 5 days prior to surgery
- If you would like your post-operative pain medications before your surgery date, please request this and come to my office to pick it up.

Pre-Op Appointment and Lab Work

- Both of these should be scheduled by the surgery scheduler if needed
